- Precedent. If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or 3.3 transferred to an instream use under ORS 537.348 and OAR 690-077-0070 or OAR 690-077-0075 a new injury review shall be required, and a prior short term lease shall not set a precedent for the amount of water to be leased or transferred instream.
- Suspension of original use. During the period of the lease, the owner agrees to suspend use 3.4 of water allowed under the subject water rights and under any water right that is supplemental to the subject water rights. In the event that a supplemental water right is not part of this lease, it may be subject to forfeiture






