- 2.3 Term of lease. This lease shall terminate on October 31, 2007.
- Flow protection. The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see Section 2.2).

  As part of regulation activities the watermaster or a designee has access to the point of diversion and place of use for the water rights involved in this lease. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.

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#### ~III~ Other Information

- 3.1 Accuracy. The Undersigned Lessor(s) and Lessee(s) declare that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, the information contained in this application is true, correct and complete. If after the lease order is signed, any information is determined to be false, the lease order may be modified or terminated. The lease only exercises the water rights being leased, for the term of the lease. It shall not be construed to overcome any claim that the water right may otherwise be subject to forfeiture for nonuse pursuant to ORS 540.610 during the period of time prior to the execution of the lease.
- 3.2 Lease. Lessor(s) and Lessee(s) agree to lease the water rights listed in Section(s) 1.5 for instream use for the term of this lease through Lessee to the Trustee, the Oregon Water Resources Department, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.348(2) and OAR 690-077.
- 3.3 Precedent. If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or transferred to an instream use under ORS 537.348 and OAR 690-077 a new injury review shall be required, and a prior lease shall not set a precedent for the amount of water to be leased or transferred instream.
- **Suspension of original use.** During the period of the lease, the water right holder agrees to suspend use of water allowed under the subject water rights and under any water right that is supplemental to the subject water rights.

3.5	Termination provision.
	For multiyear leases, the Lessor(s) shall have the option of terminating the lease each
	year with written notice to the Department. The lease may be terminated at any time
	during the calendar year. However, if the termination request is received less then 30-
	days prior to the period of allowed instream use or after the period of allowed use has

begun for the water right(s) being leased, water may not be used under the right(s) leased until the following calendar year, unless the Director determines that enlargement would not occur. The Department may also require: Written notice to the Department with original signatures; Consent by all parties to the lease; and/or Written notice to the Watermaster's office. For multiyear leases, the lessor shall not have the option of terminating the lease, without consent by all parties to the lease. Modification to prevent injury. Allocation of water to the instream use described in 3.6 Section 2.2 during the term of this lease is not reasonably expected to cause injury to other rights to use water from the same source. If injury is found after this lease is signed, the lease may be modified or terminated to prevent injury. 3.7 Fees. 



Bear Creek Orchards leases; IL-850 and IL-851; C-80570 and 80572

Hi Steve,

We received two Bear Creek Orchards/MID lease applications today. Both applications request that "The instream right should be added to any existing instream water rights up to the estimated average natural flow."

My review of the existing ISWRs reveals two minimum perennial streamflow rights (Certificates 59818 and 59820) and one right created by a transfer (Certificate 76147).

In order to make these leases additive to the existing ISWRs, we must have information that would show that there is a beneficial use in exceeding the existing ISWRs (which are as high as 120 cfs). Ideally this information should come from ODFW, DEQ, or OPRD.

Additionally, I want to confirm the proposed rates and duties on the two leases. The first lease (IL-850) for 91.6 acres requests and instream rate and duty of 0.916 cfs and 242.74 AF for both the primary and supplemental (Certificates 80570 and 80572). However, the rate is shown as a 1/100 for the primary and a 1/80 for the supplemental.

The second lease (IL-851) requests **0.246 cfs** and 65.19 AF under the primary and **0.307 cfs** and 65.19 AF under the supplemental, yet describes both as a 1/100 cfs.

Please confirm the rates and duties associated with both of these leases. If you'd like to discuss any of this, please give me a call. Many thanks!
