By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the change.

Your application will be examined to determine if additional information is needed. You will be contacted following this examination. A number of other transfer applications are also awaiting review. As a result, it may be some time before we are able to process your application. If you wish to have your application processed more quickly, you may want to consider use of the Department's reimbursement authority. Under this authority an applicant may receive expedited review by paying the full cost for a pre-qualified contractor to process the applications.
