- 1.4 Validity of Rights. Lessor #1 attests that the subject water rights are legally valid by having been beneficially used according to the terms of the right or permit. If the right is for irrigation, beneficial must have occurred in the last five years on all lands indicated in Exhibit D.
- 1.5 **Lease.** All Lessors agree to lease the water rights listed in 1.4 for instream use for the term of this Agreement through Lessee to Trustee, the. Oregon Water Resources Department, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.348(2) and OAR 690-77-077.
- Suspension of original use. During the period of the lease, the owner agrees to suspend use of water allowed under the subject water rights and under any water right that is supplemental to the subject water rights.
- 1.7 **Water use reporting.** The Trustee agrees to fulfill legal obligations related to water use reporting.

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- 2.1 **Public Use.** The public use served by the amount, timing and location of the instream use provided for under this lease is a specific need identified by ODFW and further described in *Exhibit E*.
- 2.2 **Instream use created by lease.** The instream use to be created is described as follows:

Certificates: 25032 and 3339

Rock Creek

Tributary to John Day River in the Lower John Day Basin.

Cripe's ditches; NW¼SE¼, Section 30, Township 1 South, Range 22 East, W.M. and N. 5 deg. 10'W. 1104 feet from ¼ corner between Section 5, Township 2 South, and Section 32, Township 1 South, Range 22 East, W.M., being within the NE¼SE¼SW¼ of said Section 32. To the next pod in the system with a junior priority.

Conditions to prevent or mitigate injury, if any:

- 2.3 **Term of lease.** This Lease shall commence on April 1, 2000 (not before execution by the parties) and continue through Sept. 30, 2002
- Flow protection. The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see Section 2.2). No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.

Optional Provisions

- Additional monitoring. Lessee intends to manage and participate in the protection of the instream use by: possibly collecting information for calculating stream discharge.
- 2.6 **Modification or termination provisions.** None

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- 3.0 **Watermaster review.** By signature below, the watermaster for the district where the subject water right is located verifies that:
- Due to the lack of comprehensive, current maps, the Place of Use identified by all the Water Rights of record for subject land are somewhat undefinable. The portions of the Water Rights named herein have been identified based on the best of field staff's ability and experience; it is the intent of this lease agreement to include all valid Water Rights appurtenant to the subject property.
- 3.2 Lessor #1 is currently entitled to appropriate water under the water rights described in Section 1.4.
- 3.3 A suitable control may be installed so that WRD staff may regulate use of water under the subject right to ensure water is not diverted or applied on lands to which subject right is attached.
- 3.4. Allocation of water to the new instream use described in Section 2.2 during the term of this lease is not reasonably expected to cause injury to other rights to use water from the same source.
