2.2 Instream use created by lease. The instream use to be created is described as follows:

John Day River

Tributary to Columbia River in the John Day River Basin.

Describe the point of diversion (POD) and any associated reach(es) of the instream use being created. If possible list the reach by river mile. If no reach is identified, and there is only one POD listed on the certificate, the lease may be processed to be protected at the POD. The instream flow will be allocated on a daily average basis up to the described rate from June 22 through September 30.

Other (describe): The initial flowrate of 0.38 cfs will be protected at the POD. Below the POD the rate will be reduced by 48% to mitigate for projected return flows; a 1% per mile flow reduction factor was applied to the rate over the 63 miles distance from the POD to the John Day River at Service Creek Gaging Station resulting in a maximum rate of 0.1 cfs being protected at the gage.

- 2.3 Term of lease. This lease shall terminate on September 30, 2008.
- 2.4 Flow protection. The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see section 2.2). As part of regulation activities the watermaster or a designee has access to the point of diversion and place of use for the water rights involved in this lease. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.

~III~ Other Information

3.1 Accuracy. The Undersigned Lessor/s, Lessee and Trustee declare that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, the information contained in this lease is true, correct and complete. If after the lease is signed, any information is determined to be false, the lease may be modified or terminated. This lease only exercises the water rights being leased; for the term of the lease; it shall not be construed to overcome any claim that the water right may otherwise be subject to forfeiture for nonuse pursuant to ORS 540.610 during the period of time prior to the execution of the lease.

- 3.2 Lease. All Lessors agree to lease the water rights listed in 1.4 for instream use for the term of this Agreement through Lessee to Trustee, the Oregon Water Resources Department, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.348(2) and OAR 690-077-0077.
- 3.3 **Precedent.** If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or transferred to an instream use under ORS 537.348 and OAR 690-077-0070 or OAR 690-077-0075 a new injury review shall be required, and a prior short term lease shall not set a precedent for the amount of water to be leased or transferred instream.
- **3.4** Suspension of original use. During the period of the lease, the owner agrees to suspend use of water allowed under the subject water rights and under any water right that is supplemental to the subject water rights. In the event that a supplemental water right is not part of this lease, it may be subject to forfeiture.

3.6	Modification to prevent injury. Allocation of water to the instream use described in Section 2.2 during the term of this lease is not reasonably expected to cause injury to other rights to use water from the same source. If injury is found after this lease is signed, the lease may be modified or terminated to prevent injury.
3.7	Fees. Effective October 1, 2003, pursuant to ORS 536.050 (1)(v) (2003 SB 820), the following fee is included: \$200 for an application with four or more landowners or four or more water rights. \$100 for all other applications.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

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THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PAUL LEVATIN 1198 ESTATES DRIVE LAFAYETTE, CALIFORNIA 94549 WATER RESOURCES DEPT SALEM, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of THE JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of THE COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 16.9 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 37162. The date of priority is AUGUST 27, 1973. The right is limited to not more than 0.42 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 13 S, R 27 E, W.M.; 950 FEET SOUTH AND 180 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.






