- 1.5 **Validity of Rights.** Lessor attests that the subject portion of the water right to be leased is legally valid by having been beneficially used according to the terms of the right within the last five years immediately preceding the 1997 irrigation year and, if the right is for irrigation, on the subject portion of the lands indicated in *Exhibit D*.
- 1.6 Lease. Lessor agrees to lease the subject portion of the water right listed in 1.4 for instream use for the term of this Agreement through Lessee to Trustee, the Oregon Water Resources Department, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.348(2) and OAR 690-77-077.
- 1.7 **Suspension of original use.** During the period of the lease, the owner agrees to suspend use of water allowed under the subject portion of the water right and under any water right that is supplemental to the subject portion of the water right.
- 1.8 **Water use reporting.** The Trustee agrees to fulfill legal obligations related to water use reporting.

- 2.3 **Term of lease.** This Lease shall commence on April 1, 1997 (not before execution by the parties) and continue through October 31, 1997.
- 2.4 **Compensation**. Lessor has agreed to lease the subject portion of the water right herein to the Oregon Water Trust for cash and other considerations and for the benefit of the people of the state of Oregon.
- 2.5 **Flow protection.** The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see Section 2.2). No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.

Optional Provisions

- 2.6 Additional monitoring. Lessee intends to manage and participate in the protection of the instream use by: possibly collecting information for calculating stream discharge.
- 2.7 Modification or termination provisions. None

- Watermaster review. By signature below, the watermaster for the district where the subject portion of the water right is located verifies that:
- 3.1 Lessor is currently entitled to appropriate water under subject portion of the water right described in Section 1.4.
- 3.2 A suitable control is in place so that WRD staff may regulate use of water under the subject portion of the right to ensure water is not diverted or applied on lands to which subject portion of the right is attached.

- 3.3 Allocation of water to the new instream use described in Section 2.2 during the term of this lease is not reasonably expected to cause injury to other rights to use water from the same source.
- 3.4 Necessary conditions to the proposed instream use: The rate of flow of 0.043 cfs will be added to an existing instream water right of 0.08 cfs that has the same priority date and reach of this instream right. The existing right is described under Special Order Volume 50, Page 572, approving a temporary change in use and place of use. The combined instream right will be for a rate of flow of 0.123 cfs.

PUBLIC USE PROVIDED BY INSTREAM WATER RIGHT
