Lessor agrees to donate the water right herein to the Oregon Water Trust as a charitable contribution for the benefit of the people of the state of Oregon.

- 2.3 Suspending the original use. During the period of the lease the owner agrees to suspend the use of water under the original right, or the portion of the right that is leased, and any supplemental right for the same use on the same property.
- 2.4 **Term.** This Lease shall commence on **April 1,1995** or no sooner than its execution by the parties and shall continue thereafter through **October 31, 1995**.
- 2.5 Flow Protection. The trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and agency enforcement guidance, to assure that the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past downstream users so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demands under this date of priority. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the river/stream described in Paragraph 2.2.
- 2.6 Additional monitoring. The lessee intends to manage and participate in the protection of the in-stream right as follows: [optional]
