- Term of lease. This Lease shall commence on April 1, 1999 (not before execution by the parties) and terminate on November 1, 1999.
- 2.4 Compensation. Lessor has agreed to lease the water rights herein to the Oregon Water Trust for cash and other considerations and for the benefit of the people of the state of Oregon.
- Flow protection. The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see Section 2.2). No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.

## **Optional Provisions**

- 2.6 **Additional monitoring.** Lessee intends to manage and participate in the protection of the instream use by: possibly collecting information for calculating stream discharge.
- 2.7 Modification or termination provisions. None

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- 3.0 **Watermaster review.** By signature below, the watermaster for the district where the subject portion of the water right is located verifies that:
- Lessor is currently entitled to appropriate water under the subject portion of the water right described in Section 1.4.
- 3.2 A suitable control is in place so that WRD staff may regulate use of water under the water rights to ensure water is not diverted or applied on lands to which the rights are attached.
- 3.3 Allocation of water to the new instream use described in Section 2.2 during the term of this lease is not reasonably expected to cause injury to other rights to use water from the same source.
