of Post , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Crooked River

a tributary of Deschutes River irrigation of 330.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 320 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 1, 1910

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.13 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWA SWA, Section 34, T. 16 S., R. 20 E., W. M. Diversion point located: North 18° 50' East 898 feet from 3W Corner, Section 34
