Water can be pumped from Butte Creek or two wells. The pump at Butte Creek has a 75 Hp motor with an 8-inch mainline. The wells have 100 Hp motors with 8-inch mainlines. There is Approximately 12,000 feet of mainline conveying water to places of use.

System capacity: 4 cfs cubic feet per second (cfs). If the transfer involves multiple rights that have independent systems, describe the capacity for each system separately.

Butte Creek is 2 cfs. Well 1 and Lone Pine Well are 2 cfs combined.

These acreages represent areas which are no longer irrigated because a drip system, which was installed in the summer of 2006, is now used for irrigation of cane berries on those lands. Although the cane berry crops remaining on the "From" lands cover the entire original acreages, the actual wetted area from drip irrigation represents only 30% of the original acreages.
