2.1 **Lease.** Lessor agrees to lease through lessees to holder, the water right listed in 1.2.1 for use as an in-stream water

- 2.3 Suspending the original use. During the period of the lease the owner agrees to suspend the use of water under the original right, or the portion of the right that is leased, and any supplemental right for the same use on the same property.
- 2.4 **Term.** This Lease shall commence on or not before execution by the parties and shall continue through October 1.

- 2.5 Flow Protection. The trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure that the water is delivered to the point of diversion, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demands under this date of priority. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the river/stream described in Paragraph 2.2.
