Lease. Lessor agrees to lease through lessee to holder, the water right listed in 1.2.1 2.1 for use as an in-stream water right during the term of this agreement. Lessor agrees to donate the water right herein as a charitable contribution for the benefit of the people of the state of Oregon.

- 2.5 Flow Protection. The trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and agency enforcement guidance, to assure that the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past downstream users so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demands under this date of priority. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the river/stream described in Paragraph 2.2.
