The trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure that the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past downstream users so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demands under this date of priority. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the stream described in Paragraph 2.2.
- 2.6 Additional Monitoring. The lessee intends to manage and participate in the protection of the in-stream right as follows: Possably collecting information for calculating streamflows.
- 2.7 Modification or termination provisions. None
