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- 1.5 Validity of Rights. Swalley Irrigation District inspected property and verified usage of water in last five years. Central Oregon Irrigation District is contracted to deliver the water rights at a COID's weir (Exhibit E). Land owner receives water from private ditch system. The rights are for irrigation, on all lands indicated in Exhibit D.
- Lease. Lessor agrees to lease the water rights listed in 1.4 for instream use for the term of this Agreement through Lessee to Trustee, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.348 (2) and OAR 690-77-077.
- 1.7 **Suspension of original use**. During the period of the lease, the owner agrees to suspend use of water allowed under the subject water rights and under any water right that is supplemental to the water rights.
- 1.8 **Water use reporting.** The Trustee agrees to fulfill legal obligations related to water use reporting.

- 2.3 **Term of lease.** This Lease shall commence upon execution by the parties and continue through October 31, 1998 (two years), or until terminated by either Swalley Irrigation District or the Oregon Water Resources Department.
- 2.4 **Compensation.** The general nature of the lease compensation is removal from the lessor of any further assessments by Swalley Irrigation District for the 0.25 acre water right.
- Flow protection. The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to 2.5 prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see Section 2.2). No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.

Optional Provisions

2.7 Modification or termination provisions.

This lease may be terminated by either Swalley Irrigation District or the Oregon Water Resources Department upon written notice to the other party. The effective date of termination shall not be during the irrigation season (April 1 - October 31). This lease may be extended by mutual agreement of Swalley Irrigation District and the Oregon Water Resources Department.
