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





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Other (describe): The instream right protected under this lease shall be satisfied based on the same percentage diversion and delivery rate that Medford Irrigation District is providing to irrigation rights within the District. The instream rate proposed is estimated based upon a 1/100th cfs per acre rate. In ease of shortage of supply where the general allotment on the District has been reduced, the District may deliver less than 2.65 acre feet ner acre in accordance with District policy governing temporary instream leases. In the event the District stops delivery of irrigation water prior to October 31, the delivery for instream use shall also stop. Reporting to the watermaster shall be consistent with any required reporting of other District operations.

If you need to enter more instream uses, please use the additional water rights form.

- 2.3 Term of lease. This lease shall terminate on October 31, 2006.
- 2.4 Flow protection. The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see section 2.2). As part of regulation activities the watermaster or a designee has access to the point of diversion and place of use for the water rights involved in this lease. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.

#### ~III~ Other Information

- 3.1 Accuracy. The Undersigned Lessor/s, Lessee and Trustee declare that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, the information contained in this lease is true, correct and complete. If after the lease is signed, any information is determined to be false, the lease may be modified or terminated. This lease only exercises the water rights being leased; for the term of the lease; it shall not be construed to overcome any claim that the water right may otherwise be subject to forfeiture for nonuse pursuant to ORS 540.610 during the period of time prior to the execution of the lease.
- 3.2 Lease. All Lessors agree to lease the water rights listed in 1.4 for instream use for the term of this Agreement through Lessee to Trustee, the Oregon Water Resources Department, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.348(2) and OAR 690-077-0077.
- 3.3 Precedent, If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or transferred to an instream use under ORS 537.348 and OAR 690-077-0070 or OAR 690-077-0075 a new injury review shall be required, and a prior short term lease shall not set a precedent for the amount of water to be leased or transferred instream.
- 3.4 Suspension of original use. During the period of the lease, the owner agrees to suspend use of water allowed under the subject water rights and under any water right that is supplemental to the subject water rights. In the event that a supplemental water right is not part of this lease, it may be subject to forfeiture.



The supplemental water will be delivered to Bear Creek to satisfy the instream water right by diverting water from the Joint System Canal at the Bradshaw Drop into the East Main Canal. At the point where the East Main Canal synhon crosses Bear Creek the water will be delivered to Bear Creek through a control structure used to deliver water for District patrons in Bear Creek. The instream reach will be from the synhon, at approximately stream mile 16, downstream to the mouth of Bear Creek. The Medford Irrigation District is not responsible for protecting the instream water right through the reach. The instream right may be supplied water with this supplemental right when the primary sources are insufficient and the District is supplying water for irrigation under the supplemental right. Use of the supplemental water right to satisfy the instream right will be at a rate of 1/100° cfs per acre.
