The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other prior right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-Eightieth of one cubic foot per second (or its equivelant) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

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The instream now will be allocated on a daily average basis up to the described rate from June 21 through October 31.					
Other (describe): The portion of water protected under this lease shall be based on the same percentage diversion and delivery rate that Talent Irrigation District is diverting to rights of the same priority within the District. The instream rate proposed is estimated based upon a 1/100th cfs per acre rate. In case of shortage of supply where the general allotment on the District has been reduced, the District will deliver less than 2.65 acre feet per acre in accordance with District policy governing temporary instream leases. In the event the District stops delivery of irrigation water prior to October 31, the delivery for instream use shall also stop. Reporting to the watermaster shall be consistent with any required reporting of other District operations.

Term of lease. This lease shall terminate on October 31, 2005.					
Flow protection. The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see section 2.2). As part of regulation activities the watermaster or a designee has access to the point of diversion and place of use for the water rights involved in this lease. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.

Accuracy. The Undersigned Lessor/s, Lessee and Trustee declare that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, the information contained in this lease is true, correct and complete. If after the lease is signed, any information is determined to be false, the lease may be modified or terminated. This lease only exercises the water rights being leased; for the term of the lease; it shall not be construed to overcome any claim that the water right may otherwise be subject to forfeiture for nonuse pursuant to ORS 540.610 during the period of time prior to the execution of the lease.






