Reason(s) for amendment/modification(s): Applicant is continuing to develop water use capabilities to the maximum allowable under the existing permit. The change in authorized place of use will allow application of water to areas identified as requiring water in future developments. This application also requests that two points of appropriation currently on the permit be withdrawn. One well has never been used by the applicant under the existing permit and it is believed that this well could be better used to irrigate other areas. Another well placed on the permit has not yet been constructed and changing plans have indicated that water from this well would be better used at another location. The applicant feels that there is sufficient water production capacity in the 12 remaining wells to supply the water needed under this permit.


