#### ATTACHEMENT A

### DESCRIPTION OF DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM AND WATER USE

Opal Springs is located in Township 12S, Range 12E, SW1/4 of NE \( \frac{1}{4} \) of Section 33. 1215 feet north and 1940 feet west from the east 1/4 – section corner of Section 33.

The main spring at Opal Springs discharges from a steep slope above the Crooked River at the location described above. The diversion works are located near the bottom of the Crooked River Canyon and consist of a subsurface sheet pile wall and 60 inch diameter steel pipe installed vertically down into the rocky talus at the base of the slope. This pipe serves as a spring collector into which a turbine fan pump has been installed. The collector and pump supply water via a 20 inch diameter steel pipe to an adjacent pump house. Two steel pipelines (20 inch and 12 inch) convey water to storage reservoirs 900 feet above the Canyon floor to the Main Tanks.

The Opal Springs pump house adjacent to the spring collector contains three 150 hp, two 500 hp, and two 400 hp turbine pumps. An additional 400 hp pump is located in another building nearby. Two steel pipelines, a 20 inch diameter and a 12 inch diameter are used to convey the pumped water approximately from the Canyon floor to the Main Tanks with an elevation change of 900 feet. Water is distributed from the Main Tanks via the various reservoir and booster pump system. Total system capacity is 18.53 cfs based on pump capacity, pipe sizes and operation alternatives.
