***See Water Management Plan map attached which will visually help describe the following water delivery system.

C-53299: A submersible turbine pump on Well #1 pumps water through a 12" PVC pipe west then turns south to an existing ditch. Water travels through the ditch south about 1,300 feet to an existing storage pond. From pond, water is pumped into a 8" PVC pipe north then east for 1,000 feet, then north 1,320 feet, then east 1,320 feet to another 8" PVC that runs north and south. Water is diverted to a center pivot and hand lines on 188.7 acres from the mainlines. RECEIVED

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C-74070: A submersible 94 Hp pump on Well #1a pumps water through a 12" mainline that expands to 15" PVC south for 650' then east 1670' to Well #2a. Another 94 Hp submersible turbine pump on Well #2a delivers water south into the 15" PVC main which continues east to storage pond on the west side of Hwy 30. From pond, water is diverted into a culvert east under Hwy 30 then flows through a fish screen fitted on the bottom of 5' wide x 4' deep concrete headwall, and into a 60" concrete pipe where water is lifted about 13' to a 150 Hp booster pump. This centrifugal pump pumps water south through 12" steel pipe to be distributed through a 10" PVC southeast to a center pivot. From center pivot, an 8" PVC runs northeast to an 8" PVC running north and south the length of the water right place of use. The pump also delivers water northeast through an 8" PVC also to a center pivot. From pivot, an 8" PVC runs southeast to the north/south 8" PVC mainline described above. An 8" PVC lateral runs southeast off the north/south mainline to a third center pivot. Additionally numerous handlines are attached to the mainlines described above to irrigate land not watered by pivots.
