The total rights on the ditch is for about 2400 acres. The water in the ditch is rotated amongst the various users to allow complete irrigation of the land.

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Certificate 73587 & 73999: System capacity: <u>20</u> cubic feet per second (cfs). The delivery system is 3 miles of ditch to a lateral ditch on the property. The total rights on the ditch is for about 800 acres. The water in the ditch is rotated amongst the various users to allow complete irrigation of the land
