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2.1	Public use. This lease will increase streamflows that will benefit:

2.2	Instream use created by lease. The instream use to be created is described as follows:
	Bear Creek Tributary to Rogue in the Rogue Basin.
	Describe the point of diversion (POD) and any associated reach(es) of the instream use being created. If possible list the reach by river mile. If no reach is identified, and there is only one POD listed on the certificate, the lease may be processed to be protected at the POD. (If more than one POD is listed on the certificate, then the POD and any associated reach(es) must be identified): For the primary the points of diversion for the water right are on Little Butte Creek. One POD is North Fork Little Butte Creek: 40 feet north and 620 feet west from E 1/4 corner of section 20, being within the SE1/4 NE1/4 of section 20, Township 36 South, Range 2 East, W.M.  Another POD is South Fork Little Butte Creek: 780 feet south and 400 feet west from E 1/4 corner of section 29, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of section 29, Township 36 S, Range 2 East, W.M.  Another POD is Bradshaw Drop: SW1/4 SW1/4, Section 8, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M.  After the water is diverted under the rights it is transported via the Joint System Canal shared with Medford Irrigation District. The water is then diverted by RRVID at the Bradshaw Drop into the Hopkins Canal which crosses Bear Creek through a flume on the McAndrews Avenue Bridge. At the crossing, RRVID can deliver water to Bear Creek through a control structure. The reach of the instream water right under this lease will be from the McAndrews Bridge, at approximately stream mile 9.5, to the mouth of Bear Creek. For the supplemental right the point of diversion ( POD) for the water right is 870 feet South and 1460 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 30, within the NE ½ of the NW ½ of said section, Township 37 South, Range 1 West, W.M., this POD is commonly known as the Jackson Street diversion or the Bear Creek Feeder Canal: the instream right will be supplied by the supplemental rights when supplemental water is also being delivered for irrigation. Use of the supplemental right to satisfy the in-stream right will be at 1/100th cfs per acre delivered by leaving water
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Other (describe): The instream right protected under this lease shall be satisfied through the delivery by RRVID based on the same percentage diversion and delivery rate RRVID is providing to irrigation rights with the District. In case of Shortage of supply wher the general allotment on the District has been reduce, the District may deliver less that the 2.65 acre-feet per acre in accordance with District policy governing temporary instream leases. In the event the District stops delivery of irrigation water prior to October 1, the delivery for the instream water shall also stop. Reporting to the watermaster shall be consistent with any required reporting of other district operations. In stream water will be at 1/100th cfs and measured just below the Hopkins diversion by Hydromat guage BJBO.

- 2.3 Term of lease. This lease shall terminate on October 1, 2009.
- 2.4 Flow protection. The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see Section 2.2). As part of regulation activities the watermaster or a designee has access to the point of diversion and place of use for the water rights involved in this lease. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.

#### ~III~ Other Information

- 3.1 Accuracy. The Undersigned Lessor(s) and Lessee(s) declare that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, the information contained in this application is true, correct and complete. If after the lease order is signed, any information is determined to be false, the lease order may be modified or terminated. The lease only exercises the water rights being leased, for the term of the lease. It shall not be construed to overcome any claim that the water right may otherwise be subject to forfeiture for nonuse pursuant to ORS 540.610 during the period of time prior to the execution of the lease.
- 3.2 Lease. Lessor(s) and Lessee(s) agree to lease the water rights listed in Section(s) 1.5 for instream use for the term of this lease through Lessee to the Trustee, the Oregon Water Resources Department, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.348(2) and OAR 690-077.
- 3.3 Precedent. If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or transferred to an instream use under ORS 537.348 and OAR 690-077 a new injury review shall be required, and a prior lease shall not set a precedent for the amount of water to be leased or transferred instream.
- **3.4** Suspension of original use. During the period of the lease, the water right holder agrees to suspend use of water allowed under the subject water rights and under any water right that is supplemental to the subject water rights.

#### 3.5 Termination provision.

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WATER RESOURCES DEPT SALEM, OREGON For multiyear leases, the Lessor(s) shall have the option of terminating the lease each year with written notice to the Department. The lease may be terminated at any time during the calendar year. However, if the termination request is received less then 30-days prior to the period of allowed instream use or after the period of allowed use has begun for the water right(s) being leased, water may not be used under the right(s)

leased until the following calendar year, unless the Director determines that enlargement would not occur. The Department may also require: Written notice to the Department with original signatures; Consent by all parties to the lease; and/or Written notice to the Watermaster's office. For multiyear leases, the lessor shall not have the option of terminating the lease. without consent by all parties to the lease. 3.6 Modification to prevent injury. Allocation of water to the instream use described in Section 2.2 during the term of this lease is not reasonably expected to cause injury to other rights to use water from the same source. If injury is found after this lease is signed, the lease may be modified or terminated to prevent injury. 3.7 Fees. Pursuant to ORS 536.050, the following fee is included: \$200 for an application with four or more landowners or four or more water rights. \$100 for all other applications. 
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




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
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




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Tax Lot T36S R2W 35 D 400 - 4.5 ac






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
