To whom it may concern,

Helen Davidson is submitting a transfer to request additional points of diversions for two water rights associated with her property as a result of regulation activities by the Dist. 4 Watermaster's Office on the Cottonwood Creek system a tributary of the North Fork of the John Day River. As a result of the regulation activities on the system it was noted that Ms. Davidson was using inappropriate points of diversions to irrigate her property. Ms. Davidson has agreed to file the necessary paperwork to make the points of diversion she has been using for years "legal".

Upon assisting Ms. Davidson with the water rights research for her property we noted a discrepancy with the location of the authorized lands and the location of the fields on the ground. An aerial photo overlay with ArcGis software revealed that the adjudicated map was shifted to the east placing some of the lands on the hills to the east of the fields. We noted from CWRE Robert Bagett that there is not a discrepancy on the total number of acres irrigated once a survey was conducted on the lands for C-24925 in 2009. The only discrepancy appears to be the easterly shift in the acres.

The E-15 permit map for C-48441 revealed a gross discrepancy for the location of the lands covered under this water right. It appears that no final proof survey was conducted on this permitted water right which further complicated trying to determine the location of the acres authorized under C-48441. Upon walking the ground and inspecting the remnants of the old ditch ("Beymer Ditch"), it is my opinion that more acres were certified than what were actually used. As a result of this transfer Ms. Davidson proposes to cancel the "Non-used" acres under C-48441 that in her recollection were never used or "proved up on". I believe that the survey for this transfer and this transfer will more accurately describe the location of the acres authorized under C-48441 as a result of the better surveying technology today.

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It is my belief that these particular water rights are a candidate for clarification of the place of use to more accurately describe their location on the ground. The area where the places of use for these water rights are located is bordered by steep canyon walls on the easterly and westerly boundaries. This area has not had much survey activity over the past several years and I believe the State Engineer's survey and the application permit map were accurate to the best of the ability of the surveyor's at the time. The general shape of the fields represented on the paper water right maps can be seen on the ground visually and I believe that the State Engineer's survey accurately depicted the appropriate shape and size of the intended place of use but unfortunately didn't describe the place of use as accurately as we can today.



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
