Well 1 is also the source for Certificate 30302. Well 4 is reported to have a 50 hp irrigation pump and is connected to the piping and irrigation systems used for Wells 1, 2, and 3.

• System capacity: 4.22 (total) cubic feet per second (cfs). If the transfer involves multiple rights that have independent systems, describe the capacity for each system separately.

As indicated in the attached Claim information, the Well 1 system capacity for Certificate 30302 is 1.52 cfs, which exceeds the right. The system capacity for Wells 1, 2, and 3 under Certificates 83034 and 83893 is 3.35 cfs based on the information in the same Claim

10. Other Remarks (optional)

A pre-application conference was held on May 12, 2008 with Dorothy Pedersen and Mike McCord. Water is needed for aggregate washing, dust control, misc. cleanup (mining use), and industrial use. 64.8 acres of irrigation rights under Cert. 83893 will be converted to seasonal mining use to compensate for consumptive use. 13.4 acres of irrigation rights under Cert 30302 will be converted to storage for off-season mining use. The sources for all uses would be Wells 1, 2, 3, 4, and a proposed sump. In addition, 0.8 acres of primary right under Cert 83034 and 13.4 acres of supplemental rights under Certificate 83893 will be canceled. River-Bend is requesting 5 years to complete the transfer.






