There will be no specific "Receiving Landowners". The water will be used by the member of the Perrydale Domestic Water Association within the boundary of the Association in Polk and Yamhill counties, as shown on the attached Service Area Map

10) OTHER REMARKS:

- a. Perrydale has an Easement and Agreement signed by the Trustees of the Gordon P. Walker Trust, that runs with the land and allows Perrydale to access and use the water from this well. The agreement includes a purchase of water and an open-ended option to continue to withdraw water. Termination of the agreement is solely up to Perrydale. This agreement is attached.
- b. The existing Irrigation Use is for 0.33 cfs (148.11 gpm) on 83.3 acres. A duty of 2.5 feet per acre yields 208.25 acre/feet, or 67,858,262.5 gallons.

Perrydale understands that they will be limited to a rate of withdrawal of 148.11 gpm and a total volume of 67,858,262.5 gallons during the time period of March 1 through October 31 of each year, should the transfer be granted.
