#### GENERAL REMARKS:

1) The existing Water Rights Certificate and Final Proof Survey do not agree on the amount of acres covered by this water right. The Survey indicates that there are 417.8 acres, while the Certificate states that 344.5 acres are covered. The certificate holds and I have assumed, and am showing, that the acreages in the affected quarter-quarters are reduced from the north; that being the field edge not contiguous with the balance of the allowed acreage.

However, this survey has no intention of verifying the location of those ambiguous rights which do not belong to my client, or to those he is acquiring water rights from, nor have they been resolved by the Water Resources Department. All of the areas with the reduced acreage are on property owned by Nancy Iverson Baird, 2368 Old Hwy 99 South, Roseburg, OR 97470, (Tax

Lots 25.7.25 900 & 1000 and 25.7.36.201 & 202) and are not a part of this transfer. They are shown on both the "from" and "to" maps as part of the "remaining" rights.

- 2) There is a small strip (137.10 feet wide) of land east of Iverson Road and south of the north line of the Willoughby Churchill DLC 38, that is also owned by Nancy Iverson Baird and is also identified as "remaining" land on both maps. (Tax lor 25 7.36.101).
- 3) While preparing the Application map, I could not find any documentation that agreed with the Water Resources Department contention that there is farmable land lying between the line common to the William Churchill and Willoughby Churchill DLC's and the east quarter section line of Section 36. I checked out Douglas County Survey Records, the GLO Survey, and the USGS Garden Valley Quadrangle map. All indicate that there is, at most, a 10 foot swing between this line and the quarter section line, and that being no more than 5 feet on either side of the Iverson Road centerline. The improved road was in place prior to the 1961 field survey. The original plane table survey in the Department's records shows land between the road (the DLC line being the centerline) and the quarter section line to the east, but as stated above, no other records corroborate that.

This presents a problem when trying to describe the acreage locations by quarter-quarter and within the DLC's. I found the location of the east line of the Willoughby Churchill DLC 38 (in Section 31) to be the correct distance east of Iverson Road as shown on the Final Proof Survey map. This indicates that the total acreage between Iverson Road and the east property line is correct; it just isn't allotted into the quarter-quarter sections accurately.

After my staff consulted with WRD staff, Dorothy Pederson and Gerry Clark, it was determined that the small acreages along Iverson Road's east side, would be combined with the small strip of acreages lying in the west quarter tier of Section 31.
