Water is diverted from the Mill Race using a 460 volt, 50 hp centrifugal pump with a 6-inch-diameter discharge. The water is pumped through approximately 700 feet of 6-inch-diameter iron pipe to the crusher area. The lift is less than 50 feet. Water is used in the crushing area to wash the gravel.

10. Other Remarks (optional)

The type of use will change from manufacturing to industrial/mining and the place of use will be expanded. The manufacturing diversion rate of 1.3 cfs will not be changed. The City of Springfield is moving the river POD, which is shared by Knife River, as part of an amendment to Surface Water Registration 131. The rediversion pump POD is also being moved because the modifications the City of Springfield and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers are making to the Mill Race will leave the water depth too shallow at the authorized POD. An attached September 17, 2009 letter from the City of Springfield provides confirmation of the City's consent to the change in the POD.

<u>In addition to the above changes, the 34.7 acres of irrigation rights under Certificate 35753 will be voluntarily canceled.</u>

Certificate 10813 also will be voluntarily canceled. The right authorized use of 0.1 cfs of water from the Overflow Channel from Booth Kelly Lumber Company Mill Race for livestock watering.

Dear Ms. Colbert:

The purpose of this letter is to confirm that the City of Springfield ("City") consents to Point of Diversion change proposed by Knife River for its Certificate of Water Right 35753. The proposed change is necessary in connection with Springfield Mill Race Aquatic Ecosystem Restoration Project (Project), which is being conducted by the United States Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), with local sponsorship by the City of Springfield and support of Willamalane Parks and Recreation District (Willamalane).

The general purposes of the Project are to create a stable Mill Race inlet from the Middle Fork Willamette River to continue to supply existing authorized water uses; improve habitat conditions for anadromous salmon, red-legged frogs, western pond turtles and other species; and integrate restoration plans with the overall recreational and environmental education plans of the City. The Project involves relocation of the existing Mill Race point of diversion. (The City has already filed notice with OWRD to amend its Surface Water Registration Claim for the Mill Race (SW 131).

The existing Mill Race point of diversion, as described in SW 131, is also the authorized point of diversion under Certificate 35753, held by Knife River. The new Project point of diversion will be located a short distance upstream on land owned by Willamalane; however, the City holds a perpetual easement granted by Willamalane for the Project. The City, in turn, will use the new

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Mill Race diversion to continue to provide water under existing water rights, such as to Knife River under Certificate 35753. The change in point of diversion for Knife River will not require any structural changes to the Mill Race channel, and Knife River has committed that it will not make any changes to the channel or to park property without the consent of the City and Willamalane. Therefore, the City consents to the point of diversion change proposed by Knife River for Certificate 35753.
