Certificate 27814 – 30 HP portable electric pump with a 6" 25' suction pipe with screen. Delivery system is aluminum pipe. The first 20' is 6" diameter, reduced to 5" pipe for 1,000', reduced to 4" pipe for 600', and finally to 3" pipe for 600'. Sprinkler heads are Rainbird 10 gpm on 40' spacing.

Certificate 14139 – 8 HP electric pump on concret base with a 3" 10' suction pipe with screen. Delivery is buried 3" PVC pipe with permanent hydrants every 40'. Water is spread with 3" portable aluminum pipe and Rainbird 10 gpm sprinkler heads on 40' spacing.

System capacity: <u>C-27814 = 0.89</u> cubic feet per second (cfs). If the transfer involves

C-14139 = 0.45 cubic feet pr second (cfs).

We represent the Whitewater Ranch LLC and the McKenzie River Ranch LLC (Ranches) in the preparation of a temporary transfer application to change the place of use of two over-lapping primary water rights in Lane County, Oregon. The Ranches currently hold three water rights for use of water on approximately 60 acres of their property near Leaburg, Oregon. Two of the rights are for irrigation and one is for irrigation and domestic. The Ranches' current irrigation is for pasture and crop production.

The Ranches are in the process of initiating a new venture for the production of olive oil from trees transplanted to their property. They currently have a small eight-acre olive tree plot and intend to expand to twenty acres in 2010. In order to begin irrigation of the twenty acres of olive trees in 2010, the Ranches propose to temporarily transfer a portion of the two over-lapping irrigation rights from the current place of use to the twenty-acre olive tree parcel.

The over-lapping water rights are a 1947 right to irrigate 56.7 acres under Certificate 27814, and a 1937 right to irrigate 29.2 acres under Certificate 14139. The overlap is complex in that only a portion of Certificate 14139 overlaps a portion of Certificate 27814. I believe you will find that the maps attached to the application accurately delineate both the overlap configuration and the proposed transfer.

The Ranches are aware that the Department's transfer regulations require that one of the two primary water rights must be diminished to a supplemental right before the temporary transfer can be completed. To comply with this rule, the Ranches, in conjunction with the transfer application, are submitting an Affidavit for the Partial Diminution of a Water Right Certificate for Certificate 14139.

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
