Water is pumped from a diversion point in the Mohawk River using a 20 HP Marathon Centrifigal pump and conveyed through a 4-inch main to the pond. Water is pumped from the pond to the various areas using Toro, Hunter and RB 900 sprinklers.

System capacity: 1.04 cubic feet per second (cfs). If the transfer involves multiple rights that have independent systems, describe the capacity for each system separately.

One system provides water for two water rights.

This e-mail is to confirm our findings from reviewing the file for Application G-13489, Permit G-12735, and whether it should be included in the surface-water transfer we will be submitting. We determined that the ground water right is a stand-alone right, and the exact location of where the right is exercised is unknown. The application map does not clearly identify the location of the acreage to be irrigated, and the COBU map does not match areas that were irrigated at the time final proof was made. Therefore, we concluded that the ground water right does not need to be included with the surface-water transfers, because it is a stand-alone right, at this time.

We will submit an extension on the ground water right to extend the c-date to a point in time when all the conditions of the permit were met, and submit a revised COBU map that clearly defines the areas irrigated by the ground water right.

Hi Kelly:

This e-mail is to document our telephone conversation on December 16th regarding a map that I am preparing to accompany two transfers and a permit amendment. I will be submitting at least two or more maps for the proposed changes to Springfield Country Club's existing water rights. These rights are Application S-32520/Certificate 25691, Application S-65818/Certificate 82065, and Application G-13489/Permit G-12735. The proposed changes will move the existing surface water rights so the more senior right covers all the land that they always need to irrigate and the junior right covers land they do not need to irrigate when surface water is not available. The permit amendment to the groundwater right is to correctly show where they have always used the ground water right, which is not consistent with the final proof map. These changes mean the greens, tees, and some fairways will always be irrigated, and the fairways will not be irrigated when surface water is not available and use of the junior right is restricted. Thus, the mapping for these changes requires mapping very small areas, which are further reduced in size if all the acreages are separated out by not only ¼ ¼ section, but also Donation Land Claim and Government Tax Lots. It would be much simpler if the acreages were only described by ¼ ¼. During our conversation you recognized that the problem of mapping and tracking many very small areas would also be a burden to the Department. Therefore, we both agreed that it made sense map the acreages by ¼ ¼ section only.
