confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO. 1 in the DESCHUTES BASIN for GROUP DOMESTIC USE AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 13.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1890. The date of priority is MARCH 23, 1961. This right is limited to 0.66 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.50 CFS FOR GROUP DOMESTIC AND 0.16 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:
