Reason(s) for change(s): Removal of a push-up dam

The North Fork John Day River is critical Chinook spawning habitat and Mid-Columbia steelhead rearing habitat. The proposed transfer will address fish passage and instream disturbance by removing a push-up dam diversion and moving the point of diversion to a natural scour pool. Utilizing the natural scour pool will eliminate the yearly in-stream disturbance caused by moving the push-up dam each year. Watershed benefits are improved fish passage, habitat and connectivity, and water quality.

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife is submitting this letter of support for the transfer application(s) submitted by the North Fork Watershed Council on behalf of Bill Neal and Brian Prater on the North Fork John Day River.

While not having fully examined the individual merits and impacts of the application(s), ODFW believes that the transfer application(s) submitted by the North Fork Watershed Council on behalf of Bill Neal and Brian Prater may create a net benefit to fish and wildlife habitat in the North Fork of the John Day River. ODFW reserves its final determination until a more through review of the transfer can be conducted.

Replacement of push up dams with updated structures or diversion alternatives that allow for fish passage and potentially open up habitat in the John Day River system has been a priority of ODFW for decades.

We recommend that the Water Resources Department consider waiving a portion of the application fee pursuant to its administrative rules. We look forward to a more thorough review of each of these transfers as they proceed through the inter-agency review process.
