- 5. Notice of the application for temporary transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 6. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 7. A diversion structure and delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.
- 8. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- Well-to-well interference in the confined basalt aquifer is prevalent across the area.
   However, with inclusion of monitoring conditions establishing criteria for revocation or modification of the transfer, the proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

### Conclusions of Law

The temporary changes in place of use and point of appropriation proposed in application T-9706 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

### Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in place of use proposed in application T-9706 is approved.
- 2. The former place of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of this water right during the 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 irrigation seasons.
- 3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2009 irrigation season.

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- 4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right. In determining whether the temporary transfer is resulting in injury, the Department will consider:
  - 1) The rate of water level decline accelerates in the area and the acceleration can be reasonably attributed to water use under this transfer; or
  - 2) Continued use of water under this transfer would contribute to elevated ground water salinity in the area to the detriment of other water rights calling on the aquifer.

While ground water decline conditions will not be imposed, annual water level and water use measurements and reporting from the new point of appropriation will be required to evaluate claims of injury at this new location. The standards for measurements should be equivalent to the (7I) Willamette Basin Basalt condition.

- 5. The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 66814.
- 6. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 7. Prior to diverting water from the new point of appropriation (well), the water user **shall** install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used.
- 8. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 66814 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 66814. The remaining water right is limited to not more than 1.66 cfs, being 0.88 cfs from Well 1 and 0.78 cfs from Well 2 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.
