The description must be sufficient to demonstrate that the full quantity of water to be transferred can be conveyed from the authorized source and applied at the authorized location and that the applicant is ready, willing, and able to exercise the right.

The pump is a Berkeley B2 1/2 ZPL with 8 7/8" impeller on a 30 HP motor. This is on a dedicated 3 phase meter running at 460 volts. This feeds a 6 inch main line running underground inside our fence line a distance of 3400 ft. parallel to Shoreview Road. This feeds 4 laterals of 4 inch diameter. Lateral 1 is 800 ft, Lateral 2 is 1100 ft., Lateral 3 is 2200 ft. and Lateral 4 is 1500 ft. Each lateral has 3 inch risers to the surface spaced as close as 100 ft. apart depending on the field layout. 3 inch hydrant valves feed 3 inch aluminium irrigation pipe with 5 gpm rain bird sprinklers on 24-36 inch risers at 30ft. spacing on the pipe. There are several thousand feet of aluminum pipe and enough rain birds to be able to run multiple sets and to keep the pump running 24 hours a day if the weather conditions require that much irrigation. A typical set will use around 50 - 60 rain birds and a large set will use up to 80 rain birds. The system can get up to 450 gpm in the lower elevation fields. The pump curve shows that it will deliver 350 gpm at its peak efficiency of 69% on the highest elevation ground.
