	Reason(s) for change(s): A dramatic decrease in Wright's Creek flow about 19 years ago resulted in the PODs being relocated to a nearby reach of the Molalla River.

# 5. WATER DELIVERY SYSTEM

There is a 15-horsepower centrifugal pump on the bank of the river. There is about 15-foot elevation difference between the pump intake and the pump location. There is about an additional 20-foot elevation gain from the river pump to where it open flow discharges to the lake on the golf course. The main line from the river to the lake is 8 inches in diameter. Water is pumped from the river during the night for irrigation during the early morning/daytime. There are two variable speed 65-horsepower pumps in the lake that deliver water to the irrigation system at 103 psi.

The maximum system capacity from the river is 2.83 cfs, the maximum capacity from the lake is 3.22 (1.61 cfs per pump). The capacity of the system is much greater than any of the individual certificates or the total of all three together (1.41 cfs).

#### 10. Other Remarks (optional)

The PODs for Certificates 20444 (1948), 34110 (1961), and 36264 (1966) were moved to the mainstem of the Mollala River about 19 years ago when the flow in Wright's Creek decreased. Note attached evidence that Wright's Creek is a side channel of the Molalla River.

There are minor inconsistencies between the final proof surveys (FPSs) for the certificates. There is also an inconsistency between the acreage on the FPS and the certificate for 20444; the certificate listing of acreage was utilized. When each subsequent FPS was generated a configuration of the more senior rights was included and the configuration of these older rights are not consistent from FPS to FPS. The configurations that appear to be most representative for 20444, 34110, and 36264 are included on this transfer application map and the acreage is consistent with the certificates.

There are two overlaying supplemental rights: G-11205 and S-49956. If this historic POD change is approved S-44956 will be cancelled. Underlaying GR-2062 is not being changed as part of this transfer.




