Water has been diverted into the Upper and Lower Phillips Ditches. What water that has been available via a ditch from the Lower Phillips Ditch has been used to flood irrigate when possible. A 5 hp gas pump (on site) has also been used to pump directly from the river into a 7,000 gal holding tank, then re-pumped using an electric submersible pump to a sprinkler system from faucets and hoses.




