
- 1. Application for a Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon was applied for by Victor Butler on April 9, 1929 as S 12658. Applicant's map shows proposed place of use North of river on applicant's property.
- 2. Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon was approved on May 10, 1929.
- 3. Extensions were granted to numerous permit holders including Victor Butler as follows:
 - a. Volume 2, page 172, 10-6-1931
 - b. Volume 2, page 251, 1-9-1933
 - c. Volume 2, page 368, 6-28-1934
 - d. Volume 2, page 382, 11-19-1934
 - e. Volume 2, page 495, 11-20-1935
- 4. Certificate 11698 was issued on March 2, 1937 apparently with no final proof map having ever been created. In 1937, OWRD was responsible for creating the final proof maps, not the landowners as today.
- 5. The pasture is bordered to the North by rim rock and to the East and South by the Crooked River as can be seen below.

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Typical of place of use between river and rim rock.


- 6. Judging by overlaying the application map on an aerial photo below, the applicant was only able to roughly describe the shape of the pasture and guess how much fell in to each ¼ ¼ section. To this day, the ¼ ¼ section lines have not been surveyed and no fences exist on them.
- 7. Even without ¼ ¼ section surveys, however, the Place of Use could not have been South of the river nor up the rim rock as happens when the application map is overlaid on a modern aerial photo or in OWRD's mapping program. The Place of Use could only have been intended to be where it currently exists.
- 8. Therefore, we request to redescribe Certificate 11698's Place of Use to match its existing true shape. That true shape can be seen on the attached CWRE map along with additional water rights being transferred adjacent to those under discussion.
