

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. A request to renew a short-term lease agreement, which proposed to lease all or a portion of certificate(s) 46462 for instream purposes, was submitted to the Department by:

Lessor Greg Nelson Melinda Lear P.O. Box 10 Scio, OR 97974

- 2. The Department assigned this lease agreement number L-204.
- 3. The lease application includes the required information under OAR 690-077-0077(3). The Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(6).
- 4. The following changes have been from the original lease agreement.
 - a. Greg Nelson and Melinda Lear are the lessors.
 - b. The instream flow will be protected at 0.54 cfs from June 22 through September 30.
 - c. The lessor shall have the option of terminating the lease each year, with written notice to the Department by May 22, which is 30 days before the lease would be exercised.
- 5. The lease will terminate on September 30, 2007.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Department concludes that the lease, as modified above, will not result in injury or enlargement, OAR 690-077-0077.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED that the Short-Term Lease described herein is APPROVED.

under Permit No. 39007 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 21, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.54 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEA NEA, Section 8, T. 10 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 710 feet North from the EL Corner, Section 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secures under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

23.2 acres SE¼ NE¼ 19.8 acres NE¼ SE¼ Section 8 T. 10 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the land; or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the FFB 05 2010 Water Policy Review Board.
