(a) A report prepared by a title company that includes a legal description of the subject lands (i.e. the "from" lands or lands to be affected by the modification) and lists who the landowner(s) was:

(b) Notarized statements consenting to the modification signed by all persons, other than the applicant, who are named on or assigned to the ground water registration, who are landowners identified in the ownership report, or who are authorized representatives to whom the interest in the water right has been conveyed as identified in a water right conveyance agreement. Other documentation demonstrating that the applicant is authorized to pursue the modification may be submitted in the absence of consent.
I (we) affirm that the applicant is a municipality, as defined in ORS 540.510(3)(b), and that the right is in the name of the municipality or a predecessor. Therefore, pursuant to OAR 690-382-0400(16)(b), the applicant is <u>NOT</u> required to provide the above described report of ownership information.
I (we) affirm that the applicant is an entity with the authority to condemn property and is acquiring the property to which the ground water registration proposed for modification is appurtenant by condemnation.
