5. WATER DELIVERY SYSTEM

The description must be sufficient to demonstrate that the full quantity of water to be transferred can be conveyed from the authorized source and applied at the authorized location and that the applicant is ready, willing, and able to exercise the right.

The POD is a concrete cylinder set in the creek with openings in the bottom of the cylinder set in the creek. A 1 horsepower (HP) pump pushes water approximately 50 feet to what is locally called the water "shed" (not to be confused with the Water Resources definition of "watershed"). The water "shed" has a tank that has 6 baffles. After the water passes through the 6 baffles it is pumped by two 1 HP submersible pumps to a water filter. A meter that measured gallons per minute (GPM) is on the line between the tank with 6 baffles and the filter. Then the water flows to a 13,000 gallon tank next to the water "shed" where it is treated with soda ash and chlorine. (The local people call this 13,000 gallon tank the "clear well" although it is not a "well" in the Water Resources sense.) The water is then pumped directly to both a 125,000 gallon tank and the entire quasi-municipal use area, a group of homes. 8" diameter and sometimes 6" diameter pipelines are used to distribute the water throughout the place of use. This data was obtained from Allen Tuck of Fishhawk Lake on Jan. 4, 2010, except pipe sizes that were obtained from the permit map.
