confirms the right to use the waters of THE CROOKED RIVER AND PRINEVILLE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-2223, tributaries of THE DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 292.1 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 587.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 25991. The date of priority is <u>APRIL 8, 1914</u>. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 21.98 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FROM DIRECT FLOW AND STORAGE FROM THE RESERVOIR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, AND SHALL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE USER AND THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.




