2.3 Term of lease. This lease shall terminate on 10/31/2010.

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2.4 Flow protection. The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see Section 2.2). As part of regulation activities the watermaster or a designee has access to the point of diversion and place of use for the water rights involved in this lease. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.

confirms the right to use the waters of THE CROOKED RIVER AND PRINEVILLE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-2223, tributaries of THE DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 292.1 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 587.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 25991. The date of priority is APRIL 8, 1914. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 21.98 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FROM DIRECT FLOW AND STORAGE FROM THE RESERVOIR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, AND SHALL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE USER AND THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

BOWMAN DAM - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 11, T. 17 S., R. 16 E., W.M.; 1650 FEET SOUTH AND 300 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
