In your own words tell us what change(s) you want made and the reason for the change(s): I want to add a point of appropriation/well on our property to use our ground water rights. I currently do not have access to ground water on this property, because the existing well is located on Lynn Pope's property. The new well I dig will serve only the property which I now own.

The water rights proposed for transfer are located within a irrigation district. The irrigation

district provides our primary water right from the Klamath reclamation project. The water rights proposed for transfer are not subject to the district. After talking with Dorothy Pedersen about this, she said we should note the irrigation district on the application, and explain the situation. She said a Supplemental Form D was not necessary.

Under the current certificate, the existing well has a flow rate of 1.57 cfs. I am requesting that our proposed well have the same flow rate of 1.57cfs for the following reasons. The proposed land to be irrigated under this transfer has a center pivot on it for irrigation. The center pivot is designed to operate at a minimum of 1.57 cfs for maximum efficiency. Replacement of sprinklers, flow regulators, watering timers, and possibly slower drive gearboxes would be needed to accommodate a smaller flow rate of water. When a crop needs water, it is critical to get water applied in a timely fashion to reduce stress on the crop. By using a smaller flow rate it is possible to get behind on a watering schedule, and in turn use more total water than is necessary by simply playing catch up all of the time. A smaller flow rate will ultimately end up using more acre feet of water since it can not be applied as efficiently as with a higher flow rate. A 1.57 cfs flow rate will result in maximum efficiency of ground water to be used. Please refer to ORS 537.621 pg 70 #4

Description of Water Delivery System System capacity: 1.57 cubic feet per second (cfs) OR gallons per minute (gpm) Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Currently ground water is pumped by the turbine well pump directly into a undergound mainline. The well pump pressurizes the water, and it is piped directly into a center pivot, two wheelines, and a gated pipe system. The well pump pumps water at 1.57 cfs, and only the pivot can operate, the two wheelines, or the gated pipe system. Only one system can operate at a time with 1.57 cfs, not all 3.
