Application for District Temporary Water Right Transfer for Portion of CW-58 Re:

Dear Greg:

Pursuant to our various discussions and our meeting with Tom Paul on April 13, 2010, please find enclosed an Application for District Temporary Water Right Transfer, which proposes to temporarily change the place of use for a portion of CW-58. Also, please find enclosed a check in the amount of \$1567.20 which covers the application fee. The fee amount includes \$600 for the base fee and \$967.20 for the per acre fee (483.6 acres \times \$2/acre).

As discussed below, please note that this application is being submitted to the Department contingent on the Department's approval of the Claim of Beneficial Use (COBU) for CW-58. Thus, we understand and request that the Department will effectively hold this application for acceptance until after the COBU for CW-58 has been approved, which will make CW-58 a water right subject to transfer. Likewise, the District will not deliver and the landowner will not apply CW-58 water to the proposed "TO" ground until after the COBU for CW-58 has been approved.

Here is a summary of what I understand to be the steps in the overall process we discussed on April 13:

- 1) The Department is currently reviewing the COBU for CW-58. Assuming the COBU is satisfactory, OWRD will determine the COBU acceptable, and CW-58 will then become a water right subject to transfer.
- 2) Following completion of item 1), the Department will then accept the enclosed application for district temporary water right transfer, which will temporarily transfer 483.6 acres of CW-58 water to lands that are currently covered by Stage Gulch Critical Ground Water Area (CGWA) Subarea D water rights. We understand this temporary transfer would normally be effective

upon "receipt," but per the above, we are requesting that it not be considered effective until the Department accepts the CW-58 COBU. As we have discussed, CW-58 water has not been used on the CW-58 "FROM" lands in 2010, and because the transfer is temporary (and the CW-58 water right in combination with the Subarea D water right are still deficient), the CW-58 will remain primary.

3) Once the Department finds the CW-58 COBU acceptable under item 1) and the Department then accepts the district temporary transfer application for the CW-58 right under item 2), then the Department will issue the final order approving application T-10692. The T-10692 "TO" lands are the same as the CW-58 "FROM" lands. The T-10692 water right will remain primary, while a portion of the Permit S-54561 water right that is appurtenant to these same lands, will be diminished from primary to supplemental, per the T-10692 order. We understand that if the CW-58 right were to revert back to the CW-58 "FROM" lands before the T-10692 right is proven up and transferred elsewhere, then the CW-58 right and the T-10692 right would be considered "layered," and one or the other would need to be diminished to supplemental status. As we discussed, in the event that the T-10692 right is not proven up and transferred off prior to 2011, a further district temporary transfer application for the CW-58 right will be filed for an additional year in order to prevent the reversion from occurring. Further, we understand that the portion of Permit S-54561 that is being diminished to supplemental status on the T-10692 lands will either need to follow the T-10692 right in any subsequent transfer of the T-10692 right, or the supplemental Permit S-54561 water could eventually be transferred to ground with a different primary irrigation water right with similar reliability.

With the above in mind, I would note that section 5 on page 3 of the enclosed application requires a written statement identifying supplemental water rights that will not be transferred. The statement is contained in this transmittal letter, and is as follows: The only supplemental water right on the CW-58 "FROM" land is the portion of Permit S-54561 that will be diminished as a result of the T-10692 order. However, the CW-58 transfer will occur before the T-10692 order will be issued, and thus before the diminishment to supplemental status occurs. Further, we would note that the supplemental portion of Permit S-54561 may still be used while the transfer is effective, as it will be supplemental to T-10692 (and per the conditions in both Permit S-54561 and the T-10692 order, supplemental Permit S-54561 water may be used even if primary water under T-10692 is available.). As for the CW-58 "TO" land, there will be no supplemental right, as both CW-58 and the Subarea D rights will be primary, given the temporary nature of the transfer and given the deficient nature of these rights.


