

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines and sprinklers used to divert, convey and apply the water at the authorized place of use.

POD #1 is located on the eastern portion of the irrigated property. There is a pump in the creek and water is delivered through a pipeline and attached to either a wheel line, hand lines, or through a water gun. The water goes out on the north side of the creek only.

POD #2 is located on the western portion of the irrigated property. The water goes out on both sides of this pump. On the south side, the water flows through a pipeline and hand lines or a water gun deliver the water. On the north side, water goes across the creek in a pipe and hand lines are used to deliver the water.

We are currently in the process of installing flow meters on each pump in order to capture the 2010 water use for irrigation.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, that estate of isaac knotts Alonzo Knotts, Agent

Pilot Rock , State of Oregon , has a right to the use of the waters of East Birch Creek

a tributary of Umatille River for the purpose of irrigation of 66 acres and domestic and stock use and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 3, at page 127; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875 for 30 acres and 1892 for 36 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.83 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The point of diversion is located in the NE4 SE4, Section 4, T. 2 S., R. 32 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Estate of Isaac Knotts, Alonzo Knotts, Agent, and recorded at page 2575, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 71.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the use of water appurtenant to 5.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered November 20, 1964. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Estate of Isaac Knotts, Alonzo Knotts, Agent.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

To whom it may concern:

A portion of Certificate 32154 is located Section 10, Township 2 S., Range 32 E. WM. More specifically, the Umatilla River Decree allowed use of 15 acres in the SW1/4, NE1/4; 3 acres in the SE1/4, NE1/4 and 10 acres in the NW1/4, SE 1/4 of Section 10. These water rights are appurtenant to land owned by Mr. and Mrs. Adolph Weinke. The Weinke's have hired an attorney to help them correct a decree error regarding an incorrect place of use and when and if that is accomplished will be filing a historical point of diversion (POD) transfer to authorize the use of the two POD's from Birch Creek that have been in use for many years. The authorized POD for their water rights is located by the decree map in the SE1/4, SE1/4 of Section 11, Township 2 S., Range 32 E. WM. The athorized POD is not located on land they own and is no longer in use to serve their lands.

Based on my personal knowledge of greater than 20 years, I am not aware of any claim of injury filed due to the use of water at these two actual, current PODs.
