- water right may otherwise be subject to forfeiture for nonuse pursuant to ORS 540.610 during the period of time prior to the execution of the lease.
- 3.2 Lease. Lessor(s) and Lessee(s) agree to lease the water rights listed in Section(s) 1.5 for instream use for the term of this lease through Lessee to the Trustee, the Oregon Water Resources Department, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.348(2) and OAR 690-077.
- 3.3 Precedent. If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or transferred to an instream use under ORS 537.348 and OAR 690-077 a new injury review shall be required, and a prior lease shall not set a precedent for the amount of water to be leased or transferred instream.
- 3.4 Suspension of original use. During the period of the lease, the water right holder agrees to suspend use of water allowed under the subject water rights and under any water right that is supplemental to the subject water rights.

3.5 Termination provision.

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- For multiyear leases, the Lessor(s) shall have the option of terminating the lease each year with written notice to the Department. The lease may be terminated at any time during the calendar year. However, if the termination request is received less then 30-days prior to the period of allowed instream use or after the period of allowed use has begun for the water right(s) being leased, water may not be used under the right(s) leased until the following calendar year, unless the Director determines that enlargement would not occur. The Department may also require:
- Written notice to the Department with original signatures;
- Consent by all parties to the lease; and/or
- Written notice to the Watermaster's office.
- For multiyear leases, the lessor shall not have the option of terminating the lease, without consent by all parties to the lease.
- 3.6 Modification to prevent injury. Allocation of water to the instream use described in Section 2.2 during the term of this lease is not reasonably expected to cause injury to other rights to use water from the same source. If injury is found after this lease is signed, the lease may be modified or terminated to prevent injury.



Affidavit of Use

I, Lindsay Winsor, Property Manager for Shumway Conservancy, LLC, declare the following to be true:

I personally participated in and managed the application of water from Couse Creek to the entire 24.3 acres addressed by Water Right Certificate 84974 (formerly Certificate # 13208) over the period May 12, 2008 through July 1, 2008. The water was used in our effort to restore land that had been overgrazed to a stable, low-weed grass cover. Part of the land is enrolled in the CRP or CCRP programs. Other parts are being managed in the same manner as the CRP land. Water was also applied to a large garden and lawn area and the perimeter around that area to create a fire suppression space around structures.

We began to apply water as soon as the system was readied by Pendleton Grain Growers staff. We ended when the grass began to go significantly dormant due to heat about July 1 because continued application of water in that situation would benefit the weeds more than the grass. A total of 7.411 acre feet was applied.

The delivery system is described in the attached Claim of Beneficial Use filed with the Oregon Water Resources Department in July, 2008.

I have attached two photographs of water being applied as well as copies of bills for diesel fuel for the power generator for the system.
