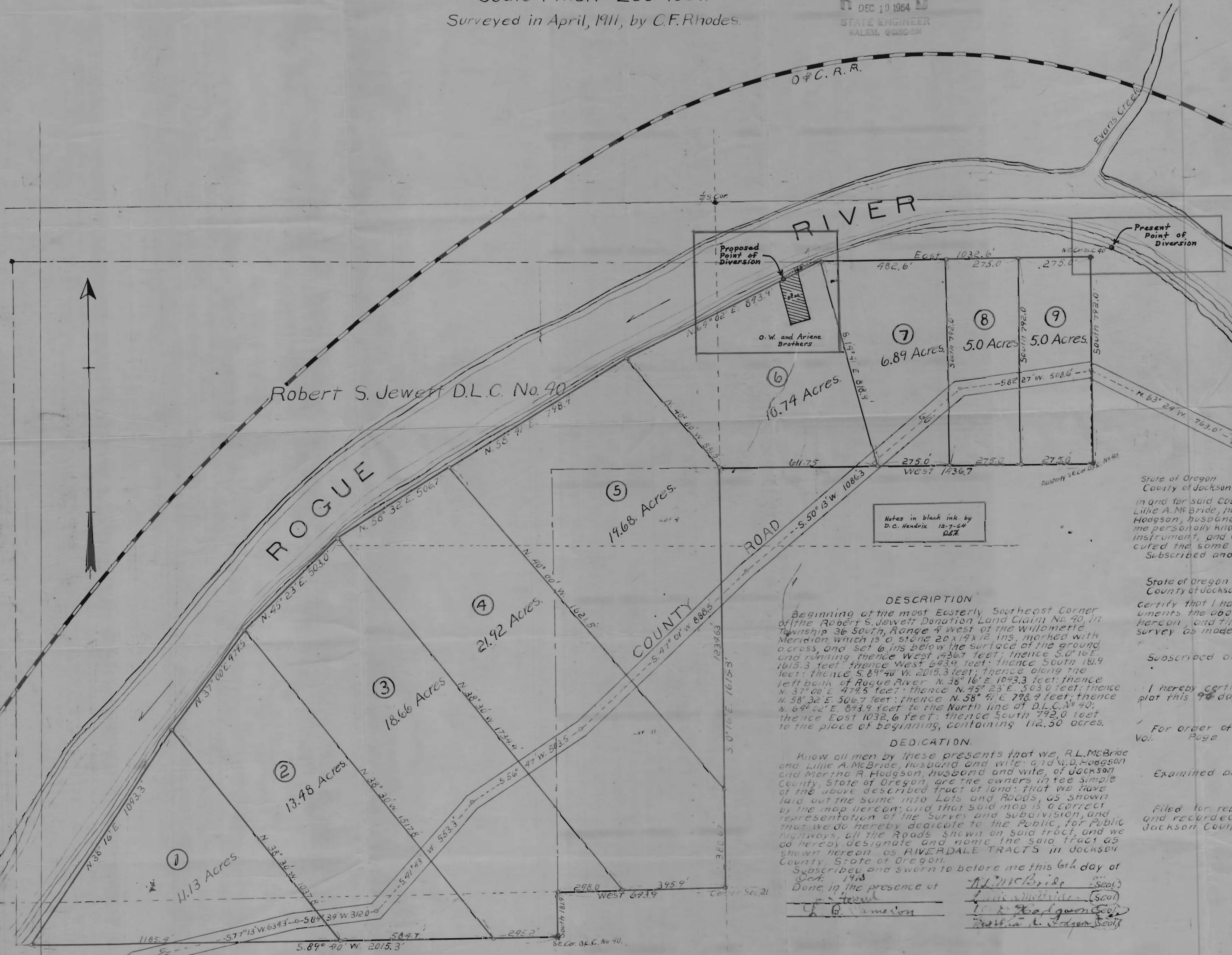


RIVERDALE TRACTS

Beginning at the most Easterly Southeast Corner
of the Robert S. Jewett Donation Land Claim No. 40, in
Township 36 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette
Meridian which is a stone 20x19x12 ins. marked with
a cross, and set 6 ins. below the surface of the ground
and running thence West 1436.7 feet; thence South 181.9
feet; thence East 843.9 feet; thence South 181.9
feet; thence East 1032.6 feet; thence South 792.0 feet
to the place of beginning, containing 112.50 acres.
thence N. 38° 16' E. 1043.3 feet; thence
N. 37° 00' E. 474.5 feet; thence N. 45° 23' E. 503.0 feet; thence
N. 58° 32' E. 506.7 feet; thence N. 58° 41' E. 798.7 feet; thence
