I, Robert B. Gould being first duly sworn do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, the lands represented upon this plat; that at the N.W. Cor. of Sec. 8 T. 18 S. R. 12 E. W.M., I buried the original 1/4 Cor. Stone 24"x18"x15" in size, ten inches below ground for the initial point of said plat; and that the following is a correct description of the lands embraced in said plat: All of the West 1/2 of Sec. 8 T. 18 S.
