Water Right Transfer Supplemental Form Map Waiver

The Director may waive or assist a transfer applicant in satisfying the map requirement (OAR 690-380-3100) for certain transfers if the criteria described in this form are met pursuant to OAR 690-380-3410.

This form must be prepared by the transfer applicant and the appropriate Regional Manager for the Oregon Water Resources Department. To prepare the form, a copy of the complete transfer application, including a description of the water rights to be transferred, must be provided to the Regional Manager.





This Is to Certify, That

FREDERIC & ROBERTA SCHILDMEYER

of Rt. 3, Box 1306, Klamath Falls , State of Oregon, 97601 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring & unnamed stream

a tributary of Upper Klamath Lake irrigation of 440.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 35928 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 2, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is united to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 11.00 cubic feet per second, being 1.75 c.f.s. from the spring and 9.25 c.f.s. from the unnamed stream

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the All within Lot 5 (SWk NW4), Section 6, T. 37 S., R. 9 E., W. M., #1-2800 feet North and 1130 feet East, #2-2640 feet North and 1140 feet East, #3-2640 feet North and 600 feet East, all from the SW Corner, Section 6

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.



CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FORNEY W. AND JENNIFER D. SCRONCE PO BOX 221 MERRILL, OREGON 97633

confirms the right to use the waters of KLAMATH LAKE, a tributary of THE KLAMATH RIVER, for THE IRRIGATION OF 350.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 41590. The date of priority is MAY 31, 1977. This right is limited to 8.75 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 13, T 37 S, R 8 E, W.M.; 1850
FEET SOUTH AND 2400 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.







Knoll Ranch LLC Transfer Application – Cert 44733 – APOD Detail Map



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
Proposed Action Planning Map, Alternative 1 Water Conveyance to Exisiting Pivot Irrigation System
