



The last problem is contributed to by the purpose of this transfer of changing from wheel lines to center pivots. The pivots leave some void areas and further bisect small units of irrigated lands. A trial map proved to be very oluttered and accountability was difficult due to the number of small parcels. Using the nearly complete pickup and respreading method will make the map easier to read, easier to review by WRD, but more expensive for the land owner.


