

On August 22, 1984, Vincent F. Lombardo submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 37813, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Harold P. and Virginia Sanders, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.034 cubic foot per second of water from Williams Creek and Kings Reservoir, with a date of priority of April 17, 1963, for irrigation of 3.25 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 27, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 37813, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.



Thank you very much for your letter of 15 May regarding my applications to store and appropriate waters of the State of Oregon.

After careful re-examination of my applications and consideration of all factors appurtenant thereto, it is my desire that you amend these applications as follows:

- (1) Flow of waters in the designated drainageways will not support an appropriation of one (1) acre foot each during the critical portion of the irrigation season. Flow is falling off rapidly even now and will be in the order of 0.01 cfs during the next two (2) months. This flow will provide only ½ acre foot or less from each source and my application must be amended accordingly. one-half (½) acre foot for storage from each drainageway. This water will be stored for stock watering during the dry season.
- (2) It is my intention to water sixty (60) head of stock at this pond throughout the year. In accordance with the best information I can obtain from reliable sources, each head of stock requires 15 gallon per day, 5475 gallon per year or sixty (60) head will require 328,500 gallon per year on a little over one (1) acre foot stored water. Consequently, my two (2) acre feet of stored water will be utilized 50% for stock watering purposes and 50% for irrigation.

Since it is readily apparent that the flow of water from the drainageways will be completely depleted during the critical portion of the season, it is my intention to fill the reservoir from Williams Creek thru the Dixon Sparlin Ditch as late in the season as possible; when my 1963 water right from Williams Creek is shut off, I will then have two (2) acre feet of water for stock purposes and possibly a single irrigation.

It appears to me that the foregoing is certainly in accordance with all the principles of good water management and should meet with whollehearted approval from your office.

I am looking forward to your early reply.

There is a statutory procedure for contesting the issuance of a certificate. The question is whether or not beneficial use of water has been made under the terms of the permit.

Permit 28814 was issued to William Katzenbach and assigned to Harold and Virginia Sanders. The time limits for completion of construction and complete application of water were October 1, 1965, and October 1, 1966. Mr. Katzenbach obtained a one year extension to complete construction and later Mr. Sanders obtained another year so both completion dates were October 1, 1967. Mr. Sanders claimed the irrigation of approximately 54.0 acres in his completion notice filed September 21, 1967. We surveyed that land claimed irrigated as 58.1 acres and inventoried 960' 4", 1260' 3", and 1520' 2" irrigation pipe with 38 sprinkler heads.

To contest this Mr. Gene Gray would have to contend that beneficial use of water was not made within the terms of the permit. We are not dealing with a perfected right so forfeiture of a right is not involved. The period of time when water was not used would be a factor if in fact the land was irrigated after the permit was issued in July, 1963, and has not been irrigated for five successive years. This would mean that the land was not irrigated after the 1965 irrigation season as we are not yet to the end of the 1971 season.

The procedure is similar to a claim that a perfected right has been forfeited. Mr. Gray would have to allege that beneficial use of water under the term of the permit was not made, state his reasons and furnish names and addresses of at least two other persons who could support his allegations and include a statement that all persons are willing to appear at a hearing. The protest must be filed with the statutory fee of \$5.00 and with proof of service upon Mr. and Mrs. Sanders.

You will note that ORS 537.260 (3) refers also to procedure under ORS 537.420 and 537.430.







Thank you very much for your letter of 15 May regarding my applications to store and appropriate waters of the State of Oregon.

After careful re-examination of my applications and consideration of all factors appurtenant thereto, it is my desire that you amend these applications as follows:

- (1) Flow of waters in the designated drainageways will not support an appropriation of one (1) acre foot each during the critical portion of the irrigation season. Flow is falling off rapidly even now and will be in the order of 0.01 cfs during the next two (2) months. This flow will provide only ½ acre foot or less from each source and my application must be amended accordingly. one-half (½) acre foot for storage from each drainageway. This water will be stored for stock watering during the dry season.
- (2) It is my intention to water sixty (60) head of stock at this pond throughout the year. In accordance with the best information I can obtain from reliable sources, each head of stock requires 15 gallon per day, 5475 gallon per year or sixty (60) head will require 328,500 gallon per year on a little over one (1) acre foot stored water. Consequently, my two (2) acre feet of stored water will be utilized 50% for stock watering purposes and 50% for irrigation.

Since it is readily apparent that the flow of water from the drainageways will be completely depleted during the critical portion of the season, it is my intention to fill the reservoir from Williams Creek thru the Dixon Sparlin Ditch as late in the season as possible; when my 1963 water right from Williams Creek is shut off, I will then have two (2) acre feet of water for stock purposes and possibly a single irrigation.

It appears to me that the foregoing is certainly in accordance with all the principles of good water management and should meet with whollehearted approval from your office.

This will acknowledge receipt of your returned applications numbered R-38650 and 38651.

Upon re-examination of the applications it appears that it is your intention to store water from the two unnamed drainageways only. The capacity of your reservoir is said to be 2 acre feet and you state that you intend to store 1 acre foot of water from each of the drainageways. If this is true, I believe that the reservoir application should be amended by deletion of Williams Creek as a source of water to be stored and since you propose to use the water stored for irrigation and stock water, it is requested that you specify the quantity which will be used for irrigation and the quantity which will be reserved for stock watering purposes.

It appears that your secondary application numbered 38651 is in satisfactory form and will be held without further action pending completion of your reservoir application. This will acknowledge two applications; one for a permit to construct Kings Reservoir and store h acre feet of water therein from Williams Creek and waste water for irrigation and stock watering purposes and one for a permit to appropriate 1.85 cubic feet of water per second from Williams Creek and Kings Reservoir for the irrigation of 1h8 acres, a tracing and fees in the sum of \$32.90 for which our receipts numbered 37708 and 37709 are enclosed.

Your applications have been examined and filed in the order of their acknowledgment under files numbered R-38650 and 38651. Upon examination of your reservoir application, it is noted that you propose to store water from waste. From the information you have submitted, it appears that you intend to appropriate water from Williams Creek through Dixon-Sparlin Ditch for storage in your reservoir. You do not give any indication as to where the waste waters might come from. Please submit an explanation as to the source of the waste water, showing any required ditches for its collection on your application map.

Dear Mr. Steimer:

There is a statutory procedure for contesting the issuance of a certificate. The question is whether or not beneficial use of water has been made under the terms of the permit.

Permit 28814 was issued to William Katzenbach and assigned to Harold and Virginia Sanders. The time limits for completion of construction and complete application of water were October 1, 1965, and October 1, 1966. Mr. Katzenbach obtained a one year extension to complete construction and later Mr. Sanders obtained another year so both completion dates were October 1, 1967. Mr. Sanders claimed the irrigation of approximately 54.0 acres in his completion notice filed September 21, 1967. We surveyed that land claimed irrigated as 58.1 acres and inventoried 960' 4", 1260' 3", and 1520' 2" irrigation pipe with 38 sprinkler heads.

To contest this Mr. Gene Gray would have to contend that beneficial use of water was not made within the terms of the permit. We are not dealing with a perfected right so forfeiture of a right is not involved. The period of time when water was not used would be a factor if in fact the land was irrigated after the permit was issued in July, 1963, and has not been irrigated for five successive years. This would mean that the land was not irrigated after the 1965 irrigation season as we are not yet to the end of the 1971 season.

The procedure is similar to a claim that a perfected right has been forfeited. Mr. Gray would have to allege that beneficial use of water under the term of the permit was not made, state his reasons and furnish names and addresses of at least two other persons who could support his allegations and include a statement that all proof of service upon Mr. and Mrs. Sanders. persons be filed with the statutory fee of \$5.00 and with The protest


