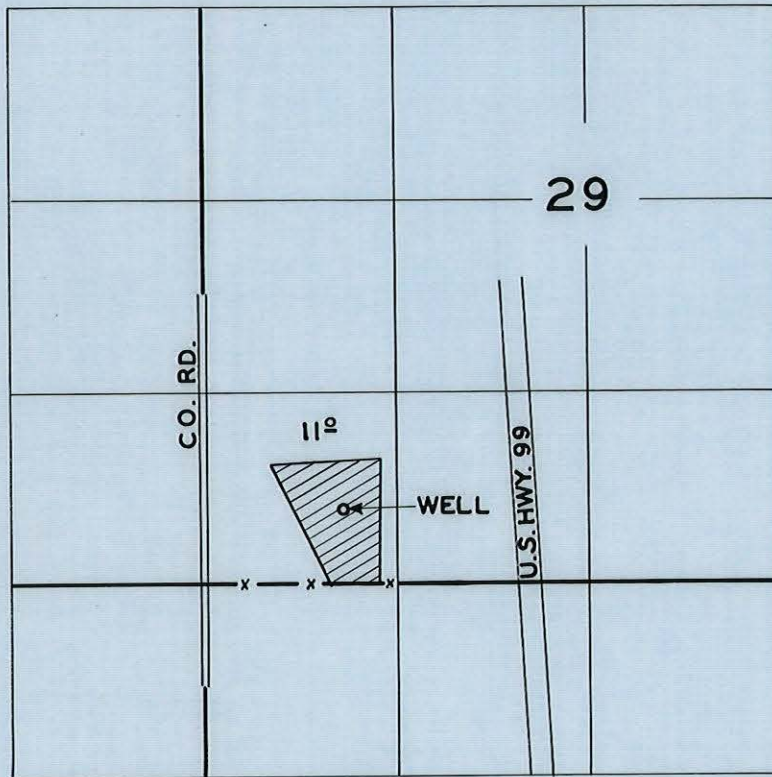

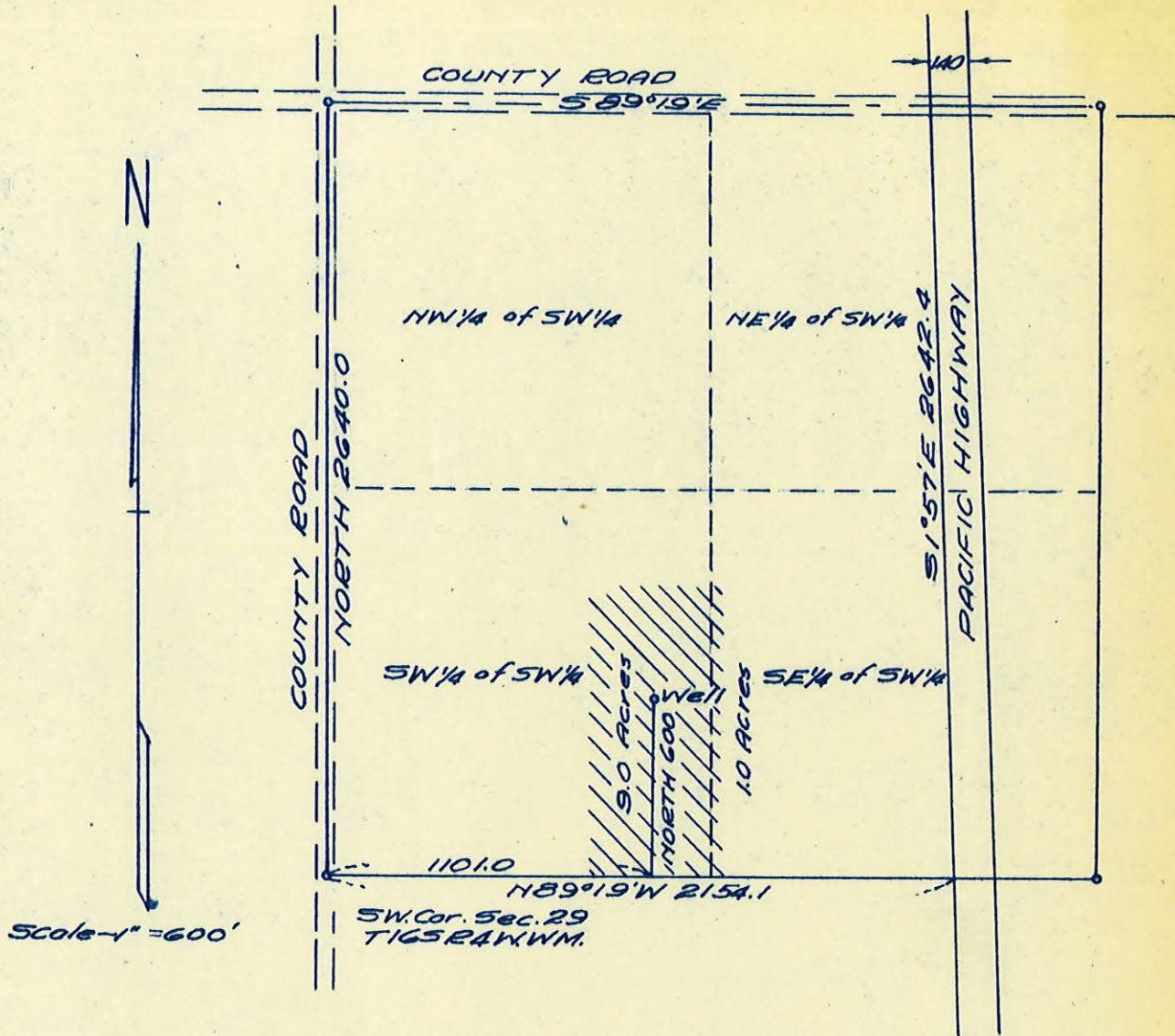

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **BEN or VIRGINIA SIMPSON**

of **Rt. 2, ~~Box~~ 5055, Junction City**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well **Clear Lake Rd,** a tributary of **Willamette River** for the purpose of irrigation of **10.0 acres**

under Permit No. **G-220** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **April 26, 1956**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.13 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T. 16 S., R. 4 W., W.M.** Well is **500 ft. N. & 940 ft. E.** from SW corner, Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet** per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 29
T. 16 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Dear Mr. Simpson:

This will acknowledge receipt of the annual well report and accompanying letter.

The confirming certificate is not issued until after an inspection or survey is made by a representative of this office which is not scheduled until the expiration of the time limit for complete application of water or until the owner of the permit notifies us that complete use of water has been made as described in the permit.

Your letter indicates that use of water has been made under the terms of your Permit No. G-220 and the final proof inspection will be made the next time a field engineer is in your area.

In previous years we were limited to one field engineer which resulted in a large backlog of final proof surveys to be made. We are rapidly reducing this backlog, however are not able to make the surveys immediately after the completion notices are submitted. The permit which you have is evidence of your right to use of water as described in the permit and other than continued use of water no action is required by you until the final proof inspection is made.

Dear Sir and Madam:

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to construct a well and appropriate therefrom 135 gallons of water per minute for the irrigation of 10 acres and the accompanying sketch. Since the required fees were not received with the application it cannot yet be filed.

The application has been examined, however, and the following discrepancies noted.

Under Item 3 the intended use should be listed as irrigation.

Under Item 4 the location of the well must be filled out in ink and further must be located within a 40 acre tract.

Since the distribution equipment will be portable it is not necessary to fill out Item 5.

Under Item 12 the land you propose to irrigate should be located within specific 40 acre tracts and the number of acres in each tract should be shown.

A legal description of the property on which the water will be used must accompany the application and can be copied word for word from your deed, abstract, or title insurance.

For the map accompanying the application to be acceptable it must conform to the requirements set forth on pages 6 and 7 of the enclosed copy of the Rules and Regulations of the State Engineer. It should be prepared in black ink on a good quality tracing cloth or paper and should show the location of the well in relation to an identified, established government survey corner and further should show the land you propose to irrigate within 40 acre tracts and with the acreages within each tract indicated.

ATTENTION WELL OWNERS

Ground water is one of our most valuable resources, and you, the well owner, have a personal responsibility in helping to preserve these resources so that they will still be available for future generations. Your most important duty in this regard is the keeping of accurate records of changes in water levels, quantities of water pumped, and all other changes in the characteristics of our ground-water resources. It is chiefly through your observations that we know what is happening and are able to prevent depletion or contamination of our ground-water supplies.

The measurement of water levels in wells is the only way we can tell if the ground-water resources of an area are being depleted. For that reason, water level measurements given in your annual reports should be as accurate as possible.

We will be glad to supply you with any information we have in regard to methods of measuring water levels, or in measuring quantities of water pumped. Your cooperation in making the annual well report a document of value will be greatly appreciated.

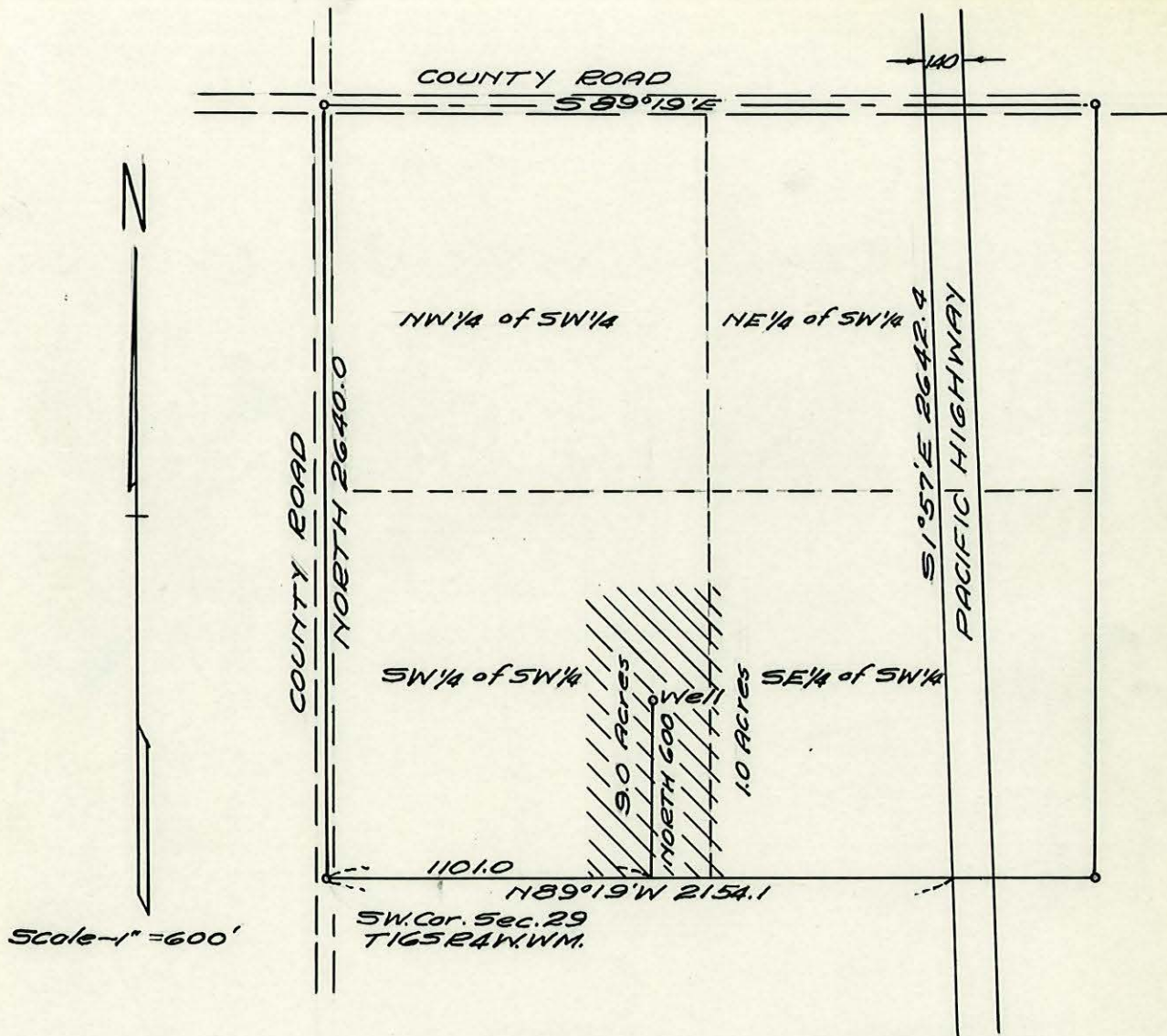
